| <p><b>Goal # 1: EXAMPLE</b><br/>           Pass all my math courses with at least a 90 or better (this might be a goal for a student planning to go to college to be a math teacher)</p> <p><u>Long-term goal:</u> will take four years of high school to achieve</p> | <p><u>Specific-</u> GPA of 90+ in every math course<br/> <u>Measureable-</u> reaching a 90+ average in each course<br/> <u>Attainable-</u> will require a great deal of studying, but it is reasonable to assume I can achieve it since I already do well in math.<br/> <u>Realistic-</u> 90+ is not unrealistic for a math teacher and I have the ability to do it.<br/> <u>Time-</u> each school year I will come closer to achieving this goal- the plan will span four years.</p> <p><u>Mini-Goals:</u><br/>           *Spend one hour each night on math homework<br/>           * Pass college level pre-calculus with a 90 average.</p> |
