The Frank Paro Memorial Scholarship

The Frank Paro Scholarship is given in memory of a man whose dedication and hard work allowed him to play an important role in the Plattsburgh Educational Community. Mr. Paro, a former teacher and administrator in the Plattsburgh City Schools, was also one of the original founders of the Plattsburgh City School District Federal Credit Union. This credit union has been serving employees of the City School District for more than 50 years.

The scholarship is to be awarded to the students who best embody attributes similar to Mr. Paro.

Eligibility

The applicant must be enrolled in an accredited two or four year college or technical institute for a full year with the intent to complete requirements for a post-secondary program of education.

Value/Duration

- This is a onetime award, non-renewable.
- This one-time scholarship awarded at graduation to Plattsburgh High School graduating senior ranges from \$250 to \$500. This amount and the number of applications receiving the award are to be determined by the scholarship committee annually.

Selective Procedure

- Student should fill out top portion of application.
- Student should ask a teacher/staff member to nominate them.
- Nominating teachers/staff should consider the following qualities in the selection of their candidate:
 - consideration of others
 - maturity
 - focus and determination
- Although consideration is given to credit union member's children that does not preclude other Plattsburgh High School graduating seniors from applying and receiving the award.
- Nomination forms are available online or from the guidance department.
- Proof of college acceptance must be provided to the guidance office.
