Vert, which established the Sarah S. Vert Student Aid Fund. The purpose for this fund is to help worthy but needy students of Clinton County to a college education. Worth and need alone are the determining factors in granting aid from this fund.

The General Harry E. Knight Scholarship Fund Committee will also meet to consider applications for scholarships. This committee was formed under the provisions of the will of Mrs. Harry E. Knight which established the Gen. Harry E. Knight Scholarships to Cornell University at Ithaca, New York for needy and deserving young men and women, irrespective of race, creed, or color, who are graduates from Clinton County High Schools, public, parochial, or private. (Students must be attending Cornell to qualify for this scholarship).

Interested students should mail separate applications to the acting secretary, Mr. John C. Lebrun, Plattsburgh City School District, 49 Broad Street, Plattsburgh NY 12901-3396 so they will be received no later than May 1, 2025. Applications must be made in writing and must contain a clear statement of the circumstances, which make financial assistance necessary. The applicant must also indicate the college to be attended. The funds at the disposal of the committees are limited. Complete application is necessary to ensure consideration by the committees.
