

Clinton County American Legion “76” Scholarship

The Clinton County American Legion offers a scholarship each year to high school graduates.

Eligibility:

1. Children of a member of the American Legion, Sons of the American Legion or Auxiliary.
2. Grandchildren of a member of the American Legion, Sons of the American Legion or Auxiliary.

The member must be a paid up member in good standing of the American Legion, Sons of the American Legion or Ladies Auxiliary.

The student must have been accepted to either a two(2) or four(4) year college. The student can be either full time or a part time (1/2 time) student.

The student must show financial need.

Selection:

Candidates will be selected on the following.

1. Community Involvement
2. Leadership
3. Character
4. Content of Essay
5. Basis of Need

An essay with a minimum of 100 words “Why I Want This Scholarship” must be submitted.

Entry Deadline:
